**A Monkey Helper Task: Fetch**

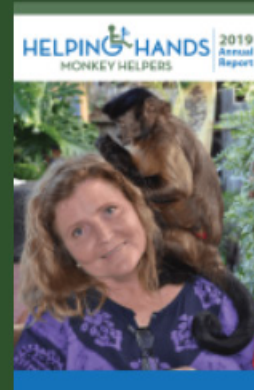

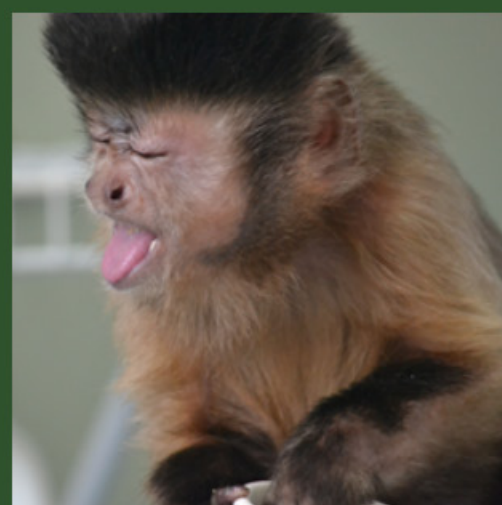
